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Chapter I INTRODUCTION

ABOUT THE COLLEGE:

MICRO VISION SOCIETY Deoli (Tonk) Rajasthan has established **R. R. College of Veterinary and Animal Science, (RRCVAS) Deoli, Tonk, Rajasthan** with a broad vision, mission and mandate. The College is affiliated with Rajasthan University of Veterinary & Animal Sciences, Bikaner. It's recognized by Veterinary Council of India, New Delhi & Govt Of India. The College follows course-curriculum as per VCI Minimum Standard of Veterinary Education-2016 (MSVE-2016). The Four Storey building is available for teaching, research and extension education



With production and clinical departments including hi-tech Veterinary Clinical Complex as well as modern Livestock Farm Complex. Eight Air Condition Theater are available to accommodate 150 students each. is equipped with audio visual aids.

The college possesses spacious laboratories with highly qualified and experienced Faculty members of National and International repute.

For practical exposures to the students of the college they will be allowed to visit different veterinary colleges, zoo, government livestock farms, national parks, etc.

LOCATION AND CLIMATE:

Deoli is a city in Tonk district, 85 km from Kota, 100 km from Ajmer and 140 Km from Jaipur in the state of Rajasthan India. It is well connected by road. The nearest Railway station is Kota,



85km and Jaipur Railway Junction, 140 km. The nearest airport is Jaipur International Airport which is 130 km from Deoli. The climate is arid and semi arid for major part of the year. The geographical area of the state is 342,239 sq km to sustain 74.79 million human and 57.73 million livestock population besides 80.24 million poultry birds. Over 55% of land is desert with rain fed crops. The State is rich in native breeds of cattle, equines, sheep and goat, camel and contributes (35%) high quality germplasm to the national pool.

FACILITIES AND AMENITIES

COLLEGE-BUILDING :

The, RR College of veterinary & animal science, Deoli has generated MSVE-2016 facilities for teaching B.V.Sc. & A.H. courses and maintained VCI standards of education. There are fully equipped and



functional departments including VCC and LFC, a well furnished library with photocopiers, Eight lecture theatres, Two examination halls, seminar halls, Separate hostels for boys and girls, indoor and outdoor games facilities, and other accessory facilities such as a computer lab to ensure the smooth running of the Veterinary College.

Besides extension, the departments are dedicated to Clinical and Para clinical Studies, Livestock Production, Management, and Livestock Production

Technology. The Veterinary Clinical Complex (VCC) and Livestock Farm Complex (LFC) are located in separate buildings under independent control. A primary purpose of the departments is to provide education and services to livestock & livestock owners.

LIVESTOCK FARM COMPLEX :-

The College has its Livestock Farm Complex as per the norms of VCI, with the following animal houses:

1. Buffaloes and Cows,
2. Sheep and Goats,
3. Pigs,
4. Equines,
5. Poultry, etc.



VETERINARY CLINICAL COMPLEX :-

RRCVAS academic activities are complemented by the VETERINARY CLINICAL COMPLEX (VCC). Student trainees get hands-on training on clinical aspects of animal diseases and sick animals being treated at RRCVAS receive clinical care as well. A variety of diagnostic services are provided by the Departments of Veterinary Medicine, Gynaecology, Surgery, and Radiology, including facilities like portable X-rays, inhalant anaesthesia, electrocautery, electrocardiography (ECG), multiparameter monitor, and microscopic demonstrations of animal diseases. The VCC is now a recognized referral clinic for complicated cases in the state's veterinary polyclinics and hospitals.





LIBRARY :-

College library is computerized and spacious with comfortable sitting arrangements. There is a well qualified and experienced librarian who manages the library. Every student will be provided books according to his/her need. Library has vast collection of text & reference books, journals and e-journals. The library has a quality Xerox and Internet facility for the students and faculty.

COMPUTER & INTERNET FACILITIES :-

The College has a well equipped computer laboratory with sufficient computers. wifi network of internet connectivity is available. Laboratory facilities are provided for courses requiring such teaching.



AMBULATORY CLINIC :-

An ambulatory clinic is operating to provide the animal treatment at door step of Farmers. Consultancy Services are also in operation particularly in adopted villages of the college.

Apart from serving the animal at door step of the farmer the student would also get an opportunity to manage and treat the cases in the animal health and treatment camp under the well qualified clinicians.



COMMITTEE ROOM / CONFERENCE HALL:-

A spacious air conditioned committee room and conference hall is also available in the college. Audio- visual aids with LCD facilities are also available. These facilities are being used for meeting, technical seminar, contest, personality development, etc.

TRANSPORT :-

Bus, Staff cars, ambulatory van and mobile diagnostics unit are available with college for Clinical activities as well as educational tour of the students.





ACCOMMODATION:-

Hostel facility will be provided to boys and girls separately. Students will be accommodated in rooms are spacious, well ventilated rooms provided with all necessary comforts. Each student will be provided in a room with a bed, a locker, a table and a chair. Air Conditioned rooms are also available. Warden and Superintendents are available to look after the general cleanliness of the hostel and to see that the students adhere to the rules & regulations. The students admitted to the college are normally required to live in a hostel if vacancies exist unless given special permission to reside outside.



SPORTS & CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:-

R.R. College of Veterinary and Animal Science, Deoli has Sports facilities like Badminton, Cricket, Table tennis, Foot-ball, Hockey, Basketball, Volleyball etc. In order to facilitate the proper conduct of these games, clubs have been constituted and each club is headed by a teacher. Students would be enrolled in NSS unit of the college as NSS volunteers to work in the field of literacy, adult and health education, etc.



EXTENSION ACTIVITIES:-

The college has adopted different villages namely Sirohi, Gawari, Rajmahal, Sitarampuram nearby of the college for the economic upliftment of the farmers. Faculty of the college used to visit these villages and participated in the Kisan Gosthi and Animal Health Camp organized by concerned Gram Panchayat. First of all the faculty had taken the survey of these adopted villages & noted all the parameters in questionnaire.

STUDENT'S COUNSELLING AND PLACEMENT CELL:-

The counselling and placement cell of the College will provide the informations to the students on job opportunities, competitive examinations, scholarships/ fellowship etc. It will also conduct trainings, arrange tutorial classes after making groups of different category of students for top ranking in the University/ Entrance examinations, Skill Development, Personality Development and explore the job opportunities in the Public.



CHAPTER II

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

DEGREE OFFERED

The B.V. Sc.& A.H. degree course is five and half years duration (four and half year course and 12 months compulsory internship as per VCI recommendations)

ELIGIBILITY (AS PER VCI NORMS).

1. The candidate must have attained or will attain the minimum age of 17 years and maximum age of 25 years on or before 31 December of that year.
2. There shall be relaxation of maximum age by 5 years for scheduled caste or scheduled tribes or other backward class candidates.
3. A candidate under general category for admission to the Bachelor of Veterinary and Animal Science Degree course shall have to qualify in each of the subjects of English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology from a recognized/ approved board of School examinations and obtained 50% marks in aggregate of these subjects.
4. In respect of candidates belonging to the scheduled caste or the scheduled tribes or other special categories of students as specified by the Govt. from time to time, much required for admission shall be 5% less than that prescribed for general category i.e., 47.5%.
5. In case result of the qualifying admission has been declared publicly but the certificate has not been issued by the concerned Board/University, such candidates shall have to produce a certificate (Annexure III) from the Head of the Institution last attended.
6. Candidates appearing/ appeared in the qualifying exam i.e., Senior Secondary or its equivalent recognized examination in that year and whose result has not been declared by the last date of submission of Admission Form may also apply but they shall not be eligible for admission to B.V.Sc. & A.H. course if they, at the time of counselling, do not produce documentary proof of passing qualifying exam with the required percentage of marks as applicable to them.

NEET-2022 (UG)/RPVT:

7. All the candidates seeking admission to the B.V.Sc & A.H. Degree Programme must appear in the NEET-2022 (UG)/RPVT.
8. **Same marks in the NEET-2022 (UG) or otherwise-** in case of two or more candidates scoring same marks in the NEET-2022 (UG)/RPVT, the merit would be decided on the basis of aggregate marks obtained in the subjects of English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology of 10+2 examinations. If still, there is a tie then the candidate senior in age will be considered higher in the Merit.

GENERAL RULES:

1. The competent authority reserves the right to reject any admission for reasons to be recorded.
2. All the state quota seats for B.V.Sc. & A.H. programme are only for Rajasthan resident candidates
3. **Admission on Management quota seats will be made on the basis of all India Merit List of NEET-2022 (UG)/ RPVT for which the candidate from all over country including Rajasthan will be eligible.**
4. The candidates who would have been allotted seats are to report for document verification and other admission formalities as per the schedule to be uploaded on the College website.
5. The candidate shall have to pay fees and other charges there and then, otherwise the seat will be declared vacant. If any candidate after completion of admission formalities does not deposit the required fee, his/her candidature will be cancelled. Also if any candidate remain absent at the time of document verification, fee deposition, he/she will not be considered in the subsequent counselling(s) even if he/she is higher in merit. Further, if a candidate refuses to accept admission on his/ her turn, he shall lose his/her right of application. He/she will not be considered for admission on the subsequent counselling even he/she is higher in merit.
6. The candidates are required to bring all the original documents, two recently taken photos and two sets of self attested photocopies of documents etc at the time of document verification failing which they shall be refused admission. The original documents of the admitted candidates shall be retained by the Dean's office & temporarily provided to the candidate on a written request for a week or upto one day before the subsequent counselling, whichever is earlier and if not written back by the date committed, admission of that candidate shall stand automatically cancelled. This document will be returned to the candidate after the completion of verification process.
7. After deposition of fees and other charges, the candidate shall get themselves medically examine, submit medical certificate on the same day in the Dean's office and complete the registration on the same day. The fees deposited by the candidate, who is medically unfit shall be refunded and his/her admission shall automatically stand cancelled. The admission of those candidates, who fail to complete any of the admission formalities, shall stand cancelled and on the request of the candidate the dues debt shall be refunded as per rules.
8. The completion of admission process involves the following-
 - (I.) Verification and submission of all the original documents along with self attested photocopies as mentioned in serial no. 9 at the time of document verification.
 - (II.) Deposition of fees and other charges.
 - (III.) Medical examinations.

9. Original and two sets of self attested photocopies of the following documents are required to be deposited at the time of Document verification and failure to produce any of the original documents shall make the candidate ineligible for the admission:

 - RPVT / NEET -2022 Admit Card
 - RPVT / NEET -2022 Marks sheet
 - RPVT / NEET -2022 Online Counselling Registration Form
 - 12th Marks Sheet & Certificate
 - 11th Mark Sheet

 - Domicile Certificate
 - Cast Certificate with issue date (as applicable)
 - Character Certificate from Principal of last attended Institute
 - T.C last attended Institute
 - Migration Certificate (if applicable)
 - Aadhar Card (Self attested photocopy)
 - Four color Photograph
 - Disability Certificate from Physically handicapped candidates (if applicable)
 - Priority Certificate from Wards of Defence/Paramilitary persons (if applicable)
 - Gap undertaking if any
 - Annexure-1 (Physical Fitness Certificate)
 - Annexure -2 (Anti ragging certificate)
 - Any other documents
10. The record related to admission process/ counselling shall be destroyed after six month of last counselling/cutoff date except that related to any pending court Case.
11. A candidate aggrieved by any decision may appeal within three days to the competent authority who will examine the application with reference to the rule and Regulations. Decision of the Chairman, Micro Vision Society, Deoli, in the matter, shall be final.
12. Admission remains provisional. Documents submitted by the candidates shall be checked/ got verified/ reverified from the concerned Board/ University at any time during course of the study. If at any stage, any certificate is found fake or not equivalent by board of school examination, or any other Board, admission will be cancelled and Legal action will be initiated.

- Regular Seats (40 No.): Admission are made through RPVT (Rajasthan Domicile only) as per rules and regulation made by Rajasthan University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences (RAJUVAS) Bikaner, Rajasthan.

EXAMINATION:

- Each professional year shall cover at least two hundred ten (210) instructional days excluding annual examination days except fourth professional year which consists of 315 instructional days.
- There shall be four professional examinations- one each after 1st, 2nd, and 3rd year as well as the 4th year after one and half year. These professional examinations shall have only the theory component with external system. The practical component shall be dealt with internally.
- There shall be three Internal Assessment examinations. Out of three Internal Assessment examinations maximum marks obtained of two internal examinations will be included in Annual examination results.
- The weightage of theory and practical shall be in the ratio of 60:40 respectively.
- The schedule of examination during Bachelor of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry course shall consist of internal assessment and annual examinations as detailed below:-

Practical Examinations: The practical examinations shall be conducted by a Board of Examiners consisting of concerned Head of the Department, teacher(s) and a representative of the Dean. The teachers while evaluating practical shall take into account the followings:-

- i. A record or log book maintained by each student as practical records.
- ii. Written test or observation and recording of the skill with which each student executes the practical.
- iii. Assessment of the comprehensive skill and knowledge of each student through an oral examination (viva-voce).

II. UNFAIR MEANS IN THE EXAMINATION:

Unfair means shall include the following:-

1. Communicating or attempting to communicate with the Controller of examination of the University or any person of his office or superintendent of Examination or person connected with the conduct of examination or with any paper setter or examiner with the object of finding out the name and address of the paper setter or examiner, for finding out the questions that have been set in by the paper setter or examiner or with the objective of influencing any of them in discharge of his/her duties in connection with the examination.
2. Giving or receiving assistance in answering the question paper to or from any other candidate/person in the examination hall or outside the examination hall.
3. Having in possession during examination time, any paper, books or notes which have relevance to the examination concerned.
4. Anything written on the ink pot cover, scales or any other instrument or on any kind of furniture with which he/she is concerned which may have relevance to the examination concerned.
5. Anything written or signs made on the body of the candidate, clothes/garments, paper or any substances, which may have relevance to the examination concerned.
6. Using or attempting to use any other unfair means during the examination or in connection with the examination.
7. Smuggling in or out an answer book or impersonating a candidate or helping an examiner/examinee.

NOTE: Impersonation (mimicked identity) will be considered as an unfair means adopted by both the parties and would be dealt with as specified in the procedural code for dealing with such cases.

- i. Copying actually from the material not to be used in the examination.
- ii. Talking or whispering to other candidate or to any unauthorized person inside or outside the examination room during the examination hours without the permission of a member of the supervisory staff.
8. Any other activity, which may give undue advantage in the examination to any student.

INSOLENT BEHAVIOUR/DISORDERLY CONDUCT DURING EXAMINATIONS:

All examinees in the examination hall or outside but within the campus of the Examination Centre during the examination shall be under the disciplinary control of the superintendent of the Centre or his nominee and shall obey his instructions.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT INCLUDES:

- a) Disobeying the instructions of the Superintendent/Add. Superintendent/Asstt. Superintendent/Invigilator or any member of the Flying Squad.
- b) Threatening, intimidation or assaulting the Superintendent/Add. Superintendent/ Asstt. Superintendent/invigilator or any member of the Flying Squad or any member of staff working at the examination centre before, during or after the examination hours.
- c) Misbehaviour with the Superintendent/Add., Superintendent/Asstt., Superintendent/ invigilator or any member of the Flying Squad or any member working at the examination centre in connection with the examination before, during or after the examination hours.
- d) Leaving the examination room before expiry of the time stipulated for doing so after the commencement of the examination or leaving the examination room without obtaining the permission of the invigilator or without handing over the answer book to the invigilator or without signing the attendance sheet.
- e) Tearing of or mutilating an answer book (Main or Supplementary) or any part thereof.
- f) Disturbing or disrupting the conduct of examination or attempting to do so.
- g) Insisting or compelling any other candidate to leave the examination room or to boycott the examination.
- h) Bringing into the examination Hall/Centre any weapon or any other material objected to by the invigilator/Centre Supt. or any other member of the supervisory staff.
- i) Appearing in the examination without being in possession of the proper admit card unless permitted by the Centre Superintendent.
- j) Refusing to be searched by the Invigilator/Centre Superintendent/any other member flying squad or obstructing or of the Supervisory staff/any staff member of the hindering such search in the examination Hall, Verandah, Urinal etc.

EVALUATION:

The examination shall be to assess whether the student has been able to achieve a level of competence and for academic assessment. Evaluation of practical aspects of the curriculum shall receive much greater emphasis leading to separate examinations and requiring the student to secure a minimum of 50% marks in theory as well as in practical in each such examination.

RULES FOR PROMOTION AND FAILURE:

1. Promotion of a student in a professional year shall be decided only on the basis of aggregate marks of internal assessment and external annual examinations.
2. A student shall be promoted to next higher professional class only if he or she has passed in all the subjects of his or her class by obtaining at least 50% marks in theory (internal and external combined) and practical separately.
3. A student should secure OGPA of 5.00 out of 10.00 at the end of degree programme to be eligible to get Bachelor of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry degree.
4. A student may also be allowed provisional promotion to next higher class till the declaration of the result of the compartmental examination provided the provisional promotion shall be subject to clearance in the compartmental examination of that or those subject(s) the student fails in the compartmental examination, he or she shall stand automatically reverted to the class from where he or she was allowed provisional promotion.
5. Failed students shall register again for the entire professional class they failed and such students shall have to fulfill all requirements of the class afresh.
6. A student failing in the annual examination for three consecutive years in a professional year of Bachelor of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry degree programme shall be finally dropped automatically from the University on account of poor academic performance except fourth professional year.
7. In no case, a student shall be allowed to continue his or her Bachelor of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry studies beyond nine academic years (excluding Internship) in a Veterinary College.

COMPARTMENTAL EXAMINATION:

1. A student failing in a maximum of two subjects only may be allowed to appear in compartmental examination for those subject(s) and the compartmental examination shall comprise of the annual component of both the theory and practical of the failed subject(s) which shall constitute 40 and 40 percent weightage, respectively, and the marks obtained in internal assessment of theory shall be considered for the evaluation of compartmental examination.
2. The compartmental examination shall be conducted within twenty calendar days of subsequent year registration and if the student fails in the compartmental examination, he or she shall be reverted back to the original class and the results of such compartmental examination shall be declared within ten days after the examination is conducted.

GRADING:

1. Grade Point in a subject shall be the total marks obtained by a student out of 100 divided by 10.
2. Credit Point in a subject shall be Grade Point multiplied by the credit hours.
3. Total Credit Points shall be the sum of the credit points secured.
4. Grade Point Average shall be the sum of the total credit points earned divided by the sum of credit hours.
5. Overall Grade Point Average shall be the sum of the grand total of credit points earned divided by the grand sum of credit hours.
6. The corresponding ranking of Overall Grade Point Average with respect to traditional scoring system of division ranking shall be as follows, namely:-
8.000 and above - First Division with Distinction
7.000 -7.999 - First Division
6.000 - 6.999 - Second Division
5.000 - 5.999 - Pass

DECLARATION OF RESULT:

- i. Result is computed and declared by the university. Joint merit list of constituent and affiliated colleges is published by the university.
 - ii. Degree and Transcript are issued by the university.
- NOTE:** Academic rules, regulations and course contents shall be modified as per RAJUVAS /VCI guidelines issued from time to time.

III. COMPULSORY INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME:

- i. Students who have completed the requirements of the course work and passed the final B.V.Sc. &A.H. examination will be allowed to enroll for the one year internship programme.
- ii. The internship programme will commence within a week of declaration of the final result.
- iii. The interns will make their own arrangements for boarding and lodging at the place of internship.
- iv. Attendance will be compulsory. The intern shall be entitled for fifteen days casual leave and the leave cannot be claimed as a matter of right until & unless the sanctioning authority.
- v. Internship programme shall include a full time training in Veterinary and Animal Husbandry services including emergencies night duties, Sundays and holidays and the intern shall devote whole time to the training.
- vi. Working hours will be regulated according to the need of the work allotted to the 20 interns.

- vii Each intern will have to complete the training satisfactory. In case of unsatisfactory work or performance or shortage of attendance of both the period of compulsory rotating internship shall be extended by two months and the student shall be re-evaluated. If again found unsatisfactory or unable to secure 50 marks out of hundred, he/she shall be given one more chance offer another two months. If he still is found unsatisfactory due to any reason, the intern has to re-register a fresh for internship programme.
- VIII The Assessment of each intern shall be based upon the evaluation of log book or project report, his or her performance reports from all the minimum prescribed training postings, entrepreneurial output, clinical case reports and their presentation, viva and comprehensive examinations in core competence in veterinary skills through a written test by an evaluation committee comprising of the faculty representing the concerned departments appointed by the Dean.
- IX After successful completion of internship, the Dean shall then issue the certificate of satisfactory completion of internship training as prescribed by the VCI.
- X A candidate shall become eligible for registration with state or union territory Veterinary Council only on the award of the B.V.Sc. & A.H. degree or production of a provisional degree certificate by the University.

IV ATTENDANCE:

1. The minimum requirement of attendance shall not be less than 75% of the scheduled theory and practical classes separately with relaxation of twenty working days for NCC or NSS, co-curricular activities and medical ground.
2. The course having 0+1 credit hours the relaxation of attendance shall be of seven days.
3. A candidate having attendance below 75% in a subject shall not be eligible to appear in the annual examination of that subject.
4. The percentage of attendance of a student in a subject shall be computed on the basis of the total number of theory and practical classes scheduled between the date of commencement of instructions and date of closing of instructions irrespective of the date of registration.
5. The students who are reverted back owing to failure in the compartmental examination, the attendance shall be counted from the date of declaration of result of compartmental examination and the date of closing of instructions.
6. The attendance of the students who reverted back for the First year shall be counted from the date of registration.
7. If a student is absent continuously for 10 working days in annual system, his/her registration in the semester/academic session will be cancelled and his/ her parents will be informed accordingly.

8. If a regular student of the college fails to register on scheduled time or fail to attend the classes after registration continuously for 45 days in annual system, without the permission of the Dean of the college, the name of student will be removed from the college rolls and his/her parents will be informed.

V. INDISCIPLINE:

Indiscipline includes:

- i. Continuous irregularity in attendance, boycotting of classes.
- ii. Causing disturbance or nuisance in classroom, college premises, office, library, playgrounds, and college administrative office.
- iii. Acts of disobedience of lawful orders, rules and regulations.
- iv. Misconduct or misbehaviour towards a member of the teaching and non teaching staff of the Institution.
- v. Causing damage to the property of the Institution or the University, disfiguring or abusing the property including library books and periodicals.
- vi. Instigating/Spreading misleading reports or rumour.
- vii. Consumption of intoxication drinks or drugs inside the college campus including hostels and play grounds.
- viii. Refusal to produce identity card on demand by the college authority.
- ix. Involvement in any criminal activity or offence during the course of studies inside or outside the campus.
- x. Possession of arms and weapons inside the college campus.
- xi. Inciting others to commit any of the aforesaid activities.

VI HOSTEL RULES & REGULATIONS:

- i. Student desirous to live in the hostel shall submit applications to the Dean of the college on the prescribed format which will be available from the office of the Dean (Annexure 3 & 4)
- ii. Students have to deposit the hostel fee as per rules. It is pertinent to mention herethat hostel fee is Non Refundable even if either the student leaves the hostel at his own choice or if the competent authority expels the student to leave hostel on the recommendation of the student disciplinary committee of the college. The concerned warden will allot the room and furniture to students, a copy of which will be endorsed to the Dean's office for cross checking of the records.
- iii. After allotment of room in the hostel, the student would have to receive furniture/other items if any, on a register meant for the purpose. While leaving the hostel, student should have to handover complete charge of the room to the warden.

NOTE: The room/seat once allotted is final and no shifting shall be made by the student at his/her own will.

Prior permission of the warden must be obtained for any change.

- iv The ragging of the student is strictly prohibited. Any student found guilty of this act be punished severely which may include expulsion from the hostel or college.
- v Neither boy student will be allowed to enter inside the Girl's hostel nor girl student be allowed to enter inside the Boy's hostel.
- vi No boy student will be allowed to go towards Girl's hostel campus & no girl student be allowed to go towards Boy's hostel campus after 5:30 pm.
- vii Lighting fire or preparing food or other eatables in the rooms is not permissible.
- viii Students are also not allowed to carry food to the room from the kitchen/dining hall.
- ix Students are strictly prohibited not to temper the electric fittings of the hostel.
- x No electric appliances (TV, Radio, Room Heaters, Electric press etc.) will be permitted in the room.
- xi Cost of any loss or damage done to the hostel property, furniture, utensils etc. shall be paid by the student at fault. If not traceable to any particular member, the cost of the damage will be recovered from all the members collectively.
- xii The room of students is liable to be checked at any time. If room is locked, the same may be opened by an authorized committee even in the absence of the concerned student.
- xiii In case of misconduct or unsatisfactory service on the part of servants, students shall immediately report the matter to the concerned warden.
- xiv Mishandling or misbehaving or assaulting hostel/ mess servants is an act of indiscipline.
- xv Items of common utility such as magazines, newspapers, radio, television, indoor game materials, utensils etc. should not be taken into the room.
- xvi Absence from the hostel from time to time will be considered a serious offence. Concerned warden may grant permission to stay out which shall generally not be granted for more than a day in a week.
- xvii Students shall not keep large sum of money or valuables in their rooms. The hostel authorities will not accept any responsibility for the goods lost by the students.
- xviii Misuse of light and water in the hostel are strictly prohibited.
- xix Each hostel will have requisite number of Block Monitors/ Monitress who will be appointed by the concerned warden. The Block Monitor/ Monitress will himself/ herself observe the hostel rules strictly and set an example of sense of duty, obedience, discipline and courteousness to the fellow members.

- xx At the time of vacation the students are required to leave the hostel within 24 hours unless and otherwise permitted by the warden. During the summer vacation the student shall have to vacate the rooms. In special cases a student may stay in the hostel after prior permission of the competent authority and shall have to pay room rent and other hostel charges.
- xxi Students are not expected to leave the station without obtaining prior written permission of the competent authority.
- xxii Throwing out waste paper, spitting, defacing the walls and committing nuisance of any kind in the hostel premises are punishable offences.
- xxiii Intoxication in any form or smoking is an offence and the student found intoxicated or smoking in the hostel premises shall be liable to punishment including expulsion from the hostel.
- xxiv Keeping of weapons and intoxicants in the room will be treated as an offence and will be dealt seriously including expulsion of the offending inmate from the hostel or college.
- xxv In case of any problem or any quarrel in the hostel premises the concerned students should report the matter in writing to the concerned warden immediately. Direct approaching to the higher authorities would be considered as an act of indiscipline.
- xxvi No guest will be allowed in the Hostel room.
- XXVii Visitors and guests will be required to sign in the hostel register meant for the purpose.
- XXViii Visitors will be allowed between 5:00 to 7:00 pm in the evening on working days and 8:00 to 10:00 am in the morning as well as 5:00 to 7:00 pm in the evening on holidays and Sundays.

Chapter - IV

RULES REGARDING PREVENTION OF RAGGING

Title, Commencement and Applicability:-

The College has adopted the UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 as well as the directions of the Hon'ble Apex Court.

They shall apply to all the students enrolled in B.V.Sc & A.H. Degree Programme or any other category of courses in which instruction/ education is imparted by the College.

What constitutes ragging:-

Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts:

- i) Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student;
- ii) Indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student;
- iii) Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student;
- iv) Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher;
- v) Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students;
- vi) Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students;
- vii) Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;
- viii) Any act or abuse by spoken words, e-mails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student;
- ix) Any act that affects the mental health and self confidence of a fresher or any other student. With or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.

Administrative action in the event of ragging:-

1. The Dean/ Principal shall punish a student found guilty of ragging after following the procedure and in the manner prescribed hereinunder:

The Anti- Ragging Committee of the college shall take an appropriate decision, in regard to punishment or otherwise, depending on the facts of each incident of

- i. ragging and nature and gravity of the incident of ragging established in the recommendations of the Anti- Ragging Squad.
 - ii. The Anti-Ragging Committee may, depending on the nature and gravity of the guilt established by the Anti- Ragging Squad, recommend, to those found guilty, one or more of the following punishments, namely;
 - a) Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
 - b) Withholding/ withdrawing scholarship/ fellowship and other benefits.
 - c) Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or other evaluation process.
 - d) Withholding results.
 - e) Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival etc.
 - f) Suspension/ expulsion from the hostel.
 - g) Cancellation of admission.
 - h) Rustication from the institution for period ranging from one to four semesters.
 - i) Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period. Provided that where the persons committing or abetting the act of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.
1. The appeal shall lie with the Chairman, Micro Vision Society within fortnight from the date of issue of orders.
 2. Where in the opinion of the appointing authority, a lapse is attributable to any member of the faculty or staff of the college, in the matter of reporting or taking prompt action to prevent an incident of ragging or who display an apathetic or insensitive attitude towards complaints of ragging, or who fail to take timely steps, whether required under these Rules or otherwise, to prevent an incident or incidents of ragging, then such authority shall initiate departmental disciplinary action in accordance with the prescribed procedure of the institution against such member of the faculty or staff.

Suspension:-

1. After having regard to the nature and gravity of the incident of ragging, the Dean of the College concerned to the students is satisfied that it is necessary/ desirable in the interest of the college to place under suspension, the student found involved in an act of indiscipline, he/she may place such student under suspension. Such suspension will not amount to any penalty having been imposed under the provisions under these rules.
2. Such suspension will debar a student from availing any facility of the college.
